“This is where it all happened!”

“*This*” is Paul’s transition from a life of drugs and homelessness to a stable and happy life.

Before coming to Earl’s Place, “All I knew was wake up and get high.” Paul is 46 years-old. For 31 of those 46 years, he was addicted to cocaine and alcohol. When he came to Earl’s Place, he had not held a legitimate job since the 1980’s. In fact, one of his former “jobs” paid him each day with drugs. Homeless for some of that time, Paul lived in the woods.

He came to Earl’s Place and his life began to change. He says the longer stay and the support of the staff eliminated some of his stress and allowed him to focus on what he wanted to do. He started volunteering at a local church. He learned how to deal with people and enjoyed always having someone around to talk to. He also learned how to be responsible with money and began

2017 Alumna saving. And most importantly, Paul has been sober for four years.

Paul describes his life now as perfect: “I’m in a really good spot.” He has a job that he enjoys, and he recently received a raise and a promotion. He has his own place, is still connected with his church, and he is happy and proud.

United Ministries, Inc., a housing and social justice organization, is both dedicated to assisting men experiencing homelessness, who want to change their lives and to changing community attitudes toward homelessness. This is accomplished with our two programs, Earl’s Place in Baltimore City and Prospect Place in Baltimore County.

Homelessness and addiction are continuing problems in Baltimore City. According to the 2017 Baltimore Point in Time Count, 2,669 people were estimated to be homeless in Baltimore. Of those, 72% were male, and 93% were single adults. Forty-four percent of the adults reported a substance use disorder and 29% had serious mental illness. Earl’s Place addresses these problems by providing recovery-focused supportive housing to men who are experiencing homelessness and seeking a sober living environment.

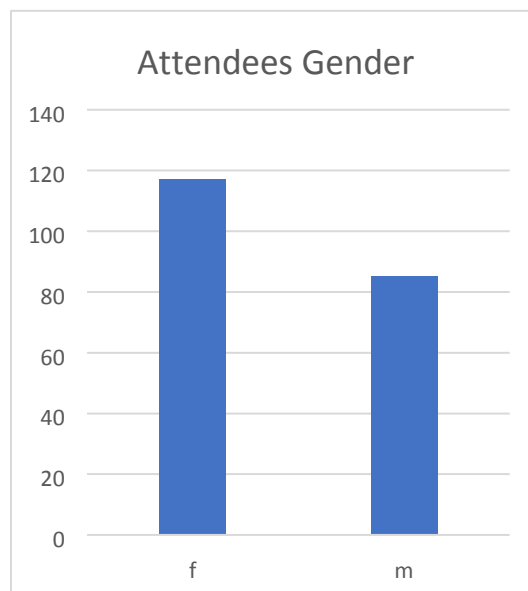
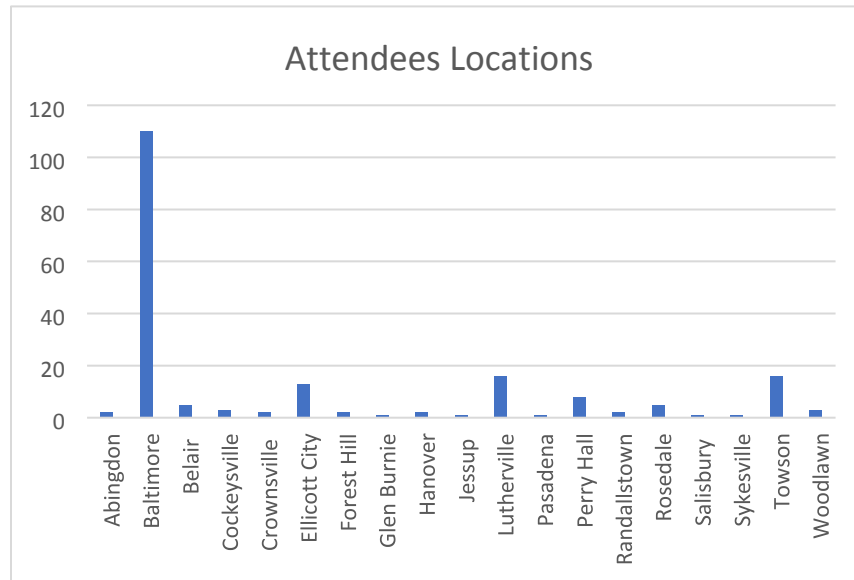
